CALL TO ORDER

Alderman Norris made a motion to amend the agenda to discuss going paperless for meetings. Aldermen Jones second the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

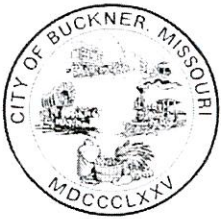
PUBLIC COMMENTS None

APPROVAL OF BILLS LIST

OLD BUSINESS

- 1. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding the wastewater treatment plant project.** Alderman Norris made a motion to allow Mayor Box to go to the bank and secure financing for the proposed reed bed system for the wastewater treatment plant. Alderman Herrin seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.
- 2. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding equipment for public works.** Alderman Norris made a motion to approve the purchase of a 2018 T870 Bobcat skid steerer from Noonday Tractor and Auction in the amount of \$52,058.24, and an additional \$1,200.00 for shipping. On condition that it passes a third-party Bobcat Dealer inspection. Alderman Jones seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

NEW BUSINESS

1. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding the appointment of Seth Meyers to the Park Board.

Alderman Jones made a motion to approve. Alderman Norris seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

2. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding purchasing tablets for the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen to be used in meetings instead of paper agenda packets.

City Administrator Bobadilla stated that he wanted to save money by purchasing seven tablets for the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen to use during the meeting instead of printing out paper copies of the agenda. The Board of Aldermen instructed him to produce the yearly saving cost for the next meeting.

3. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding new city's website.

Alderman Norris made a motion to approve Munibit's proposal of \$159.00 per month to build and host a new website for the city and obtaining a .gov domain. Alderman Walcott seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted.
